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Consideration for selection for places on the L.R.S.A.A. team for the English Schools Athletics Championships on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July 2018 is very dependent on an athlete's performance at the Leicestershire and Rutland Schools Track and Field Championships. (Athletes are **EXPECTED** to compete at the County Championships on the 9<sup>th</sup> June and any athlete unable to compete at the championships should notify the team manager before the day with an explanation of why they cannot compete.) Athletes who wish to be considered for selection for the pole vault or hammer events should forward their details to the team manager before the 9<sup>th</sup> June by email.

**Senior Age Group Athletes (year 12 and 13)** – due to the date of the County Championships coinciding with the weekend of the Regional A.A. championships for U20 athletes the selection committee will consider athletes for the team if an athlete competes in the Regional championships instead of the County Championships. Please note athletes **MUST** compete in either the County Schools Championships or the Regional Championships on that weekend. If an athlete decides to compete in the Regional Championships they must contact their team manager **BEFORE 9<sup>th</sup> June** to notify them of their decision.

Times, distances and heights achieved at other meetings recognized by UKA, AA of England, MCAA and Leicestershire and Rutland Athletics Association will be taken into consideration by the selection committee but these **MUST** be performances which are registered on the power of ten website.

Achieving qualifying times, distance and heights does **NOT** automatically guarantee selection. Other factors will be taken into account. Should it be found an athletes performance has been falsified they may not be selected in future years if they subsequently qualify.

All athletes selected to represent the Leicestershire and Rutland Schools team at the National Championships **MUST** travel on the team bus which leaves on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> July, stay in the accommodation provided by the E.S.A.A. and remain with the team for the duration of the championships.

The selection committee will select their team immediately after the County Schools Championships and all written support of performances should have been given to the team manager before the end of the County Track and Field Championships. An athlete will not be considered for selection if the necessary evidence and contact details has not been received to support their submitted performance. Athletes who are close to qualifying standards are also welcome to submit evidence of performances that are close to the entry standards. Any spaces remaining on the team following the selection meeting on the 9<sup>th</sup> June will be allocated to the first athletes who achieve the entry standard between the dates of the 13<sup>th</sup> June and 17<sup>th</sup> June.

**Please note that:**

- If the weather deteriorates during the day the meeting organiser reserves the right to either postpone an event, which will take place later in the meeting, or in extreme circumstances decide to cancel the event. This decision will be in consultation with the Area Team Managers. We also reserve the right to only allow athletes to compete in running spikes if the weather in extreme wet weather conditions.
  
- **Due to accidents at athletics events in the past that have caused serious injury and the death of an official, we are asking that all competitors remain outside the track until your event is called. Then please report to that area by going around the outside of the track. Please take care crossing the track, as there may be an event in progress. DO NOT WALK ACROSS ANY THROWING AREA. Would spectators and watching athletes, for health and safety reasons, please keep the steps and gangways clear at all times.**

**Eligibility to compete in the County Championships is as in the past, that is:**

**The first 3 finishers in an Area Championships in the 100m, 200m, 300m, 400m and Hurdles events.**

**The first 2 finishers in an Area Championships in the 800m, 1500m and any longer distance events.**

**The FIRST competitor in an Area Championships in all Field events, plus the second and third providing that they have reached the qualifying standard for that event in their Area Championships.**

**Age groups are as follows. Under 13 are Year 7 pupils only.**

**Juniors are only either Year 8 or 9.**

**Intermediates are only either Year 10 or 11.**

**Seniors are only Year 12 or 13.**

Please be aware that in the County Championships: Area numbers must be worn on the front and back for all track and field events except for high jump. Area numbers must be SECURELY pinned by at least 4 safety pins. Competitors may be excluded from competing unless properly attired.

Each race will be started as near to the published time as in the timetable, however the Referees reserve the right of making any alteration that may be necessary. **Where there are insufficient entries for heats to be held the FINAL will be held at the scheduled heat time.** If the timetable is amended, announcements will be made at regular intervals.

Each Athlete competing in an event MUST report to the marshalling area and declare their presence to the Marshalls at least 10 minutes before the race. In the case of the heats this is vital as reporting late can affect the number of heats to be run and so delay the Championships.

**Any Protests must go through the Area Team Manager or the relevant school.**

**Athletes reporting LATE after the Heat draws have been made may not be allowed to compete.**

**Qualification from the heats to the Finals for 100m, 200m, 400m and all Hurdles events will be as follows:**

- 1) If three heats held then the first TWO in each heat plus the TWO fastest losers to the final.**
- 2) If two heats held then the first TWO in each heat plus the FOUR fastest losers to the final.**
- 3) Where there are insufficient entries for heats to be held the FINAL will be held at the scheduled heat time.**
