2021 County Fell Running Championships: July 7th, 2021.

The inaugural County Fell Running Championships was held in conjunction with the West End Runners promoted Windmill Hill Fell Race (a Category B Fell Race) at Woodhouse Eaves. ... An untimely clash with England's European Football Championships Semi-Final supressed the numbers competing but did not detract from the quality at the sharp end of the race. ... Over a 2-lap 5 Mile course taking in Windmill Hill & Broombriggs Farm, the Men's race saw a keen match-up between Tim Hartley (Notts AC) & Simon Allen (OWLS AC). The outcome was only decided in the last stretch of the race with Tim taking the County title in 32-13 to Simon's 32-21. An outstanding run from Charlie Neece (Wreake & Soar Valley AC / 32-47) - the youngest runner in the race at age 16 - saw him claim 3rd place overall and the County Junior title. ... In addition to those named, the other male County medallists were Jason Williams (Calder Valley Fell Runners / 33-50) and Scott Green (OWLS AC / 34-35). ... The Women's race was also keenly contested with Caroline Warrington (Bromsgrove & Redditch AC / 39-42) taking the County honours from the West End Runners trio (all claiming County medals) of: Lucy Ellis (40-37); Sarah Horner (42-30); and Laura Davison (43-08). ... The County Association would like to thank the race organiser (Mark Lambell) & his team from West End Runners for offering us the opportunity to hold the County Championships as part of their event. ...
